You should come prepared with a number of possible objectives based on your ideas, having read the job description, and having completed the two preparatory questionnaires.

With the project supervisor you should discuss and agree on 5 to 7 objectives. After the meeting, you should create the final version of the objectives and send this to the project supervisor for approval.

At the end of the research project, a final appraisal meeting will focus on the achievement of these objectives, your experience as a research team member and any future areas of development.
